The show garnered Critics Circle Awards: DeAnna Driscoll won Outstanding Lead Performance in a Play for her riveting performance as Beatrice Hunsdorfer and Conor Martin Mulligan won for Outstanding Lighting Design. The play was also nominated for Scenic Design and received "Critics Choice" from the San Diego Reader.

ENCHANTING MUSICAL ROMP A LITTLE NIGHT MUSIC

Cygnet was thrilled to revisit one of its favorite musicals, Stephen Sondheim's *A Little Night Music*, which was a hit with critics and audiences in 2008, when it was the first show Cygnet produced at the Old Town Theatre. The 2018 production featured a diverse cast, and wowed audiences with its stunning melodies, including the ever popular, "Send in the Clowns," performed by Southern California treasure Karole Foreman. The Tony Award-winning musical is considered one of Sondheim's most beloved works.

STIRRING RHYTHMICAL DRAMA THE WIND AND THE BREEZE

We closed the season with the World Premiere of *The Wind and The Breeze* by New York based playwright Nathan Alan Davis. This poetic, slice-of-life drama was part of The Bill and Judy Garrett Finish Line Commission in 2016, where it moved audiences with its humanity and humor. The playwright was in residence and our cast and design team went to Milwaukee Repretory Theatre to workshop the play. We partnered with Urban Beats and Boys to Men to engage younger audiences, and our growing Donuts with the Directors event once again brought key stakeholders and community groups together to learn more about the show.

YOUTH ENGAGEMENT

In-School Student Workshops

Cygnet brings in-school workshops to San Diego County middle and high school students, exposing them to theatre topics like acting, playwriting, literature and history. The curriculum meets multiple San Diego Unified Visual and Performing Arts and California Common Core standards. Last year, Cygnet provided 46 free workshops, serving 1,075 students.

Student Matinees

Last year, 798 students attended free Student Matinee main stage performances. Study guides and post-show forums with the actors and Cygnet's resident dramaturge help further the students' understanding of each production.

Storytelling on the Green

Storytelling on the Green presents live, abridged works from Shakespeare and other classic authors free of charge, in the Old Town San Diego State Historic Park's **central square. Last year, over 3,000 youth and adults attended 280 performances.**

Discounted Tickets for Students

Each year Cygnet discounts ticket prices for students, totaling more than \$30,000 in savings each year.

THE BILL AND JUDY GARRETT FINISH LINE COMMISSION

Audiences enjoyed a reception with the playwrights, designer showcases, and staged readings of three new works at our second annual Bill & Judy Garrett Finish Line Commission festival. The three playwrights (one local) were each awarded a financial grant to complete their scripts.

MILITARY ENGAGEMENT

Blue Star Theatre

As a Blue Star Theatre, in collaboration with the Theatre Communications Group and Blue Star Families, Cygnet continues to offer deeply discounted tickets to military personnel, veterans, and their families, year round.

Tickets For Troops

Last year, 499 free tickets were donated to active military, veterans and their families. Cygnet Donors provide funding for this program and the tickets are distributed by our military partner agencies.

Military Performances

Cygnet Serves launched two separate performance series, of seven shows each, for a total of 14 performances serving over 400 military family members free of charge.

Individualized Military Workshops

We provided 35 weekly Creative Expressions workshops at ASPIRE, serving veterans, four quarterly workshops at Navy Base San Diego, serving active military and families, and two workshops for children from military families. Overall, we provided 41 free individualized workshops to 74 local military family members.

EMERGING ARTISTS

Recognizing that nurturing young talent is crucial for the future of theatre, Cygnet has made it a priority to give professional opportunities to young artists and designers. Thanks to a generous donation from Jeffrey and Sheila Lipinsky, Cygnet was able to hire four design fellows from San Diego State University who helped design sets, lights and costumes. Cygnet also hired a scenic designer from the University of Carolina School of the Arts and production assistants from Grossmont College and Emerson College. Cygnet also provided professional directing and acting opportunities for select recent theatre school graduates, often offering them their first Actor's Equity contract and helping launch their professional careers. Last year, Cygnet hired two artists from the University of Carolina School of the Arts and one artist from Grossmont College. Since this program began, several artists have appeared on and off Broadway and others have returned to Cygnet, including Cygnet's Associate Artistic Director, Rob Lutfy.












As a nonprofit company presenting high-quality, daring and diverse programming, Cygnet relies on donations from individuals as well as private and public sources to accomplish our mission. Because ticket sales cover only a portion of the actual cost of producing a show, the generosity of our patrons is essential to maintaining artistic integrity while keeping ticket prices affordable.

Cygnet has experienced strong revenue growth over the past few years from \$2.3M in 2014-2015 to \$2.7M in 2017-2018. Nevertheless, expenses have also increased during this time. To improve the financial position of the theatre, Cygnet cut \$300K from the fiscal budget. The biggest savings measures included reducing the size of its administrative office space, adjusting staffing levels, and reducing the number of preview performances. In addition, the company has implemented new tools to better track and control expenses.
