



FROM THE DIRECTOR

Dominique Morrisseau's work continuously speaks to all of the things I find important in the work I make – an intimate human story told against a broad backdrop. In the case of *Mud Row*, it is an intimate story about family told against the broad backdrop of history: The history of the neighborhood; American history; racial and social change in the 60's and now. With an added bonus for me of sisterhood. feminism, and centering Blackness. Mud Row is deeply rooted in community. Where do we come from? How can we break free from the paths determined for us? Although this story is a dramatization, it is rooted in a very real place while resonating in areas locally, as we have seen gentrification, the destruction of legacies, the strategic displacement of folx in need right in our own backyards. And yet, this is just one family's story.

I see so much of myself in all of the characters in this show. I empathize and understand the journeys they take. I have witnessed many of the conflicts discussed first hand. The history hits in a way that makes us want to take a step back and consider on whose legacy we are building. The rich history in this home transcends the stage. It is a reflection of the Black women who've come before me. It is a magnification of those to come after.


McKenna Perry (Scenic Design Fellow)




