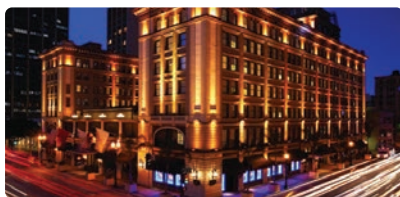

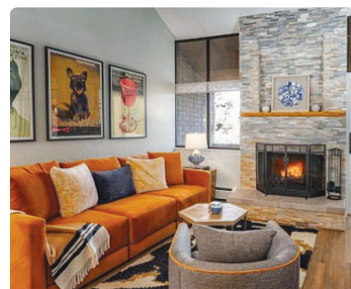

## ARTS ENGAGEMENT

All community engagement programs have the goal to broaden the base of people who engage with theatre in our community, deepen the level of engagement, promote equity, diversity and inclusion, and inspire greater empathy. All community engagement programs are offered **free of charge**.

Cygnnet Theatre sends teaching artists to middle and high schools across San Diego County to conduct **In-School Education Workshops**.

Cygnnet offers **Student Matinees** for select mainstage productions. Post-show surveys indicate that for the majority of students, this is their first time attending a live professional performance.

**Cygnnet Serves** takes theatre workshops to military site-specific locations around the county including Navy Base San Diego and the Veterans Administration APSIRE Center.

**The Bill and Judy Garrett Finish Line Commission** in partnership with the UCSD Playwriting MFA, provides support to playwrights working toward bringing their dream play to life, helping them get closer to that finish line of a fully produced production.

**The Dee Silver, MD Commission**, in partnership with The New Harmony and Playwrights' Center, provides support to playwrights in the creation of a new work that responds to our present times with hope and healing.

Cygnnet's **Emerging Artists** program helps develop the next generation of theatre artists by providing professional design, acting and directing opportunities to students and recent graduates.

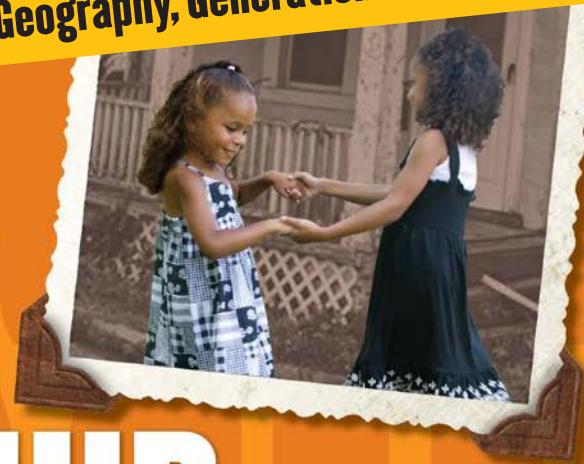
